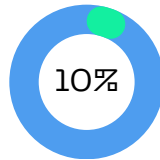


EPSS'S PROVEN IMPACT SINCE 2022

With a solid track record of **eight** successful projects, EPSS has positively impacted over **143,000** beneficiaries through risk education, trained over **1,400** focal points, mapped **100** hazardous zones, and facilitated victim referrals for **37** survivors. Partnering with UNMAS, Humanity & Inclusion and key international donors, EPSS is a vital player in the **Protection Cluster**, ensuring the safety, rights, and well-being of vulnerable populations.

9TH PROJECT UNDERWAY IN TIGRAY

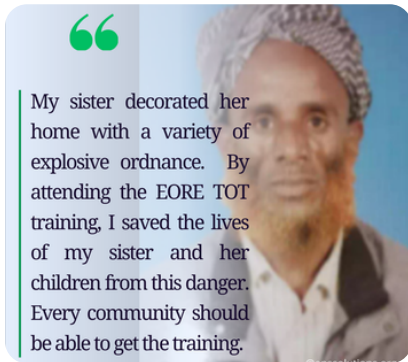
Under the **GFFO**-funded initiative, EPSS, in partnership with **HI** and **DRC**, is delivering EORE and NTS in Tigray. With a regional office in **Adigrat** and an operational hub in **Shire**, the project targets **38,566** beneficiaries by **2026**, with 10% reached so far. Additionally, **three** hazardous areas have been mapped through NTS, enhancing community safety efforts.



STRATEGIC OUTREACH & IMPACT

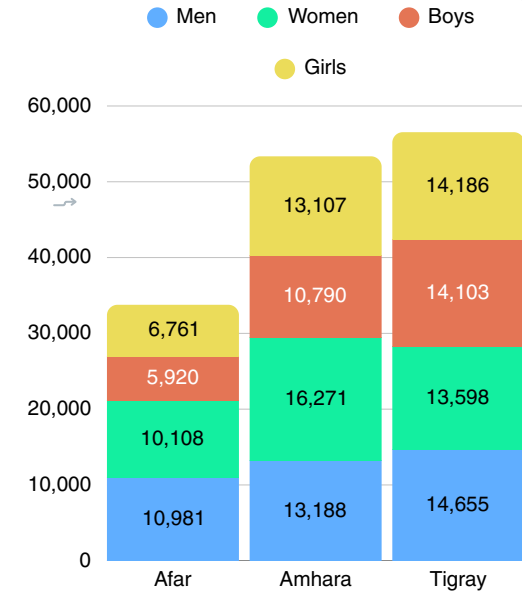
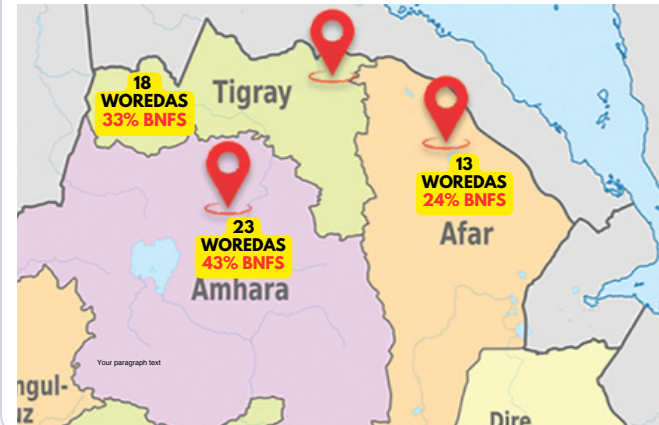
Radio-based awareness campaigns have indirectly reached 1.2 million people, while social media outreach via Facebook engaged 453,964 people.

To enhance visibility and impact, EPSS has distributed 19 billboards, 40,962 leaflets, and 12 posters across 3 regions.



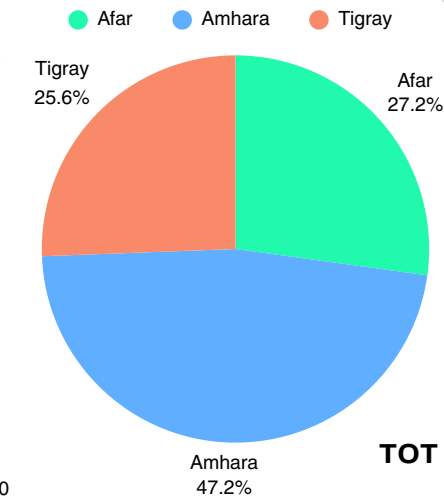
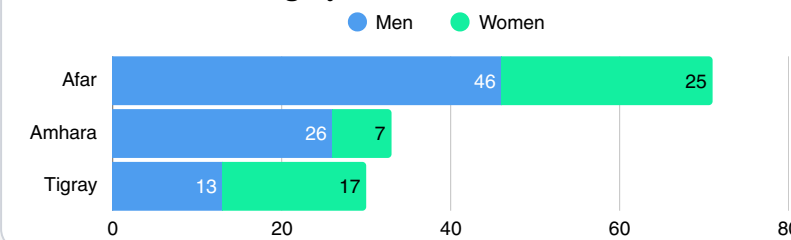
KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

EPSS has reached 143,268 beneficiaries across Amhara (53,356), Tigray (56,142), and Afar (33,770). Among them, 27,166 are **IDPs** (Afar: 3,049, Amhara: 17,655, Tigray: 6,462).



EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES THROUGH TRAINING

EPSS has strengthened local capacities through Explosive Hazard Awareness Training (EHAT) and Training of Trainers (ToT) programs. A total of 134 individuals received EHAT across Afar, Amhara, and Tigray, while 1,451 participants completed ToT programs 47.2% in Amhara, 25.6% in Tigray, and 27.2% in Afar.
